



## **Open-Enrollment Virtual Training – Developmental Parenting (2021)** **Ideas, Skills, & Tools to Engage Parents in Supporting Children’s Early Development**

**7 Webinars**, via Zoom, on developmental parenting home visiting using *PICCOLO* and *HOVRS-3*

- *Developmental Parenting Home Visiting*—rationale, approach, attitudes, strategies (1 webinar)
- *PICCOLO*—how to observe parent-child interaction to support developmental parenting (3 webinars)
- *HOVRS*—how to observe home visits to improve home visiting quality (3 webinars)

**What Developmental Parenting is about:** Our training is based on practices described in the book, *Developmental Parenting: A Guide for Early Childhood Practitioners* (Roggman, Boyce, & Innocenti, 2008). Developmental parenting refers to parent behaviors that support children’s early development and also to an approach in which practitioners facilitate developmentally supportive parenting.

**Requirements & Expectations:** We require webinar **attendance, participation**, and completion of **learning activities** (requiring about an hour). before each webinar. Webinar #1 is required to attend *any* subsequent webinars. There will be **no refunds for missed webinars**. We will **not record** and **do not allow you to record webinars**. Our webinars **do not include reliability testing**. We will explain how to establish reliability with a co-worker in webinars #4 and #7. **You may not disseminate webinar materials** (*HOVRS-3* can be used in your program, with permission; an application form will be provided).

<b>#1</b> 3/3	<b>DP-1 - Developmental Parenting:</b> Parenting that supports early child development, as measured by <i>PICCOLO</i> , and effective home visiting practices, as measured by <i>HOVRS</i> .
<b>#2</b> 3/10	<b>P-2 - Basics of PICCOLO:</b> How <i>PICCOLO</i> was developed, how it is set up, how to observe video and score it (using short example clips), and how to interpret it
<b>#3</b> 3/17	<b>P-3 - Preparing to Use PICCOLO:</b> Practice to get reliable, planning to use the measure, and introducing <i>PICCOLO</i> to caregivers.
<b>#4</b> 3/24	<b>P-4 - Implementing PICCOLO Effectively:</b> Using <i>PICCOLO</i> to identify caregiver strengths, give feedback, plan home visit activities to build on these strengths, and improve program quality.
<b>#5</b> 3/31	<b>H-2 - Basics of HOVRS:</b> How <i>HOVRS</i> was developed, the 7 Scales (4 practices, 3 family engagement), & practice observing Relationship & Responsiveness (using short example clips).
<b>#6</b> 4/7	<b>H-3 - Preparing to Use HOVRS(v3):</b> Practice observing Facilitation & Collaboration (using short example clips), and planning to use the measure
<b>#7</b> 4/14	<b>H-4 - Implementing HOVRS Effectively:</b> Practice observing Family Engagement and using <i>HOVRS</i> to provide strengths-based feedback and guide continuous quality improvement.
